Mansur in all of Andalusia in order to win public opinion. After cutting it off, this idea did not end, as it began to haunt the Umayyad state from time to time, and revolutions took place against them. Likewise, an important turning point occurred in The country of Andalusia, the entry of Shiite thought, which is divided into two parts: the thought of the Ahl al-Bayt, peace be upon them, and the Fatimid thought. After the Islamic conquest of the country of Andalusia, the thought of the Ahl al-Bayt, peace be upon them, spread through some Shiite figures who played a major role in spreading this thought among the circles of Andalusian society, and they practiced their rituals with all sincerity. Freedom, especially on the tenth day of Muharram, commemorating the martyrdom of Imam Hussein, peace be upon him. After the establishment of the Fatimid state in the Maghreb, they began to aspire to control Andalusia and eliminate their traditional enemies, the Umayyads. They succeeded in spreading their thought in Andalusia through their preachers, and the Umayyad state was able to They resisted this thought in various ways and means in order to maintain their power. They used means of intimidation, enticement, political propaganda, financial policy, etc., and various philosophical theories were applied to these events, whether ancient or modern.
